INTRODUCTION TO BRRD

BRRD refers to various regulations which require recognition of bail-in powers of certain resolution authorities (BRRD).

- Firms have indicated that many Give-Up Agreements (GUA) will need to be amended to incorporate BRRD language.
- Given the operational and legal efforts required to initiate and execute a highvolume of individual GUA amendments in a short period of time, firms requested tools to streamline their re-papering efforts.
- FIA Tech is providing a Regulatory Protocol for counterparties to incorporate in bulk into existing GUAs one of the <u>FIA Standard BRRD Article 55 Give Up Agreement Clauses (EU, UK, Hybrid)</u>.



INTRODUCING THE PROTOCOL SOLUTION

- The Protocol was designed in consideration of the established 2018 GUA Transfer Protocol framework.
- By adopting the Protocol once, parties to existing GUAs have agreed to a coordinated legal process to incorporate standard BRRD language into eligible and selected GUAs.
- Facilitates bulk re-papering efforts by supporting notices and transitions via familiar workflows and screens.



BENEFITS OF A PROTOCOL APPROACH

Workflow Efficiency:

- Eases transition and ensures uninterrupted give-up trading during regulatory driven GUA updates.
- Requires only a single Adoption event per counterparty.

Consistency of Language & Process:

- Bulk update agreements with any combination of adopting parties.
- Incorporates standard FIA Standard BRRD clauses (EU, UK, hybrid).
- Standardizes BRRD treatment and language across agreements, with Industryagreed approach.

Centralization of Transition Management:

- Monitor/determine Adopting Parties to the Protocol/Supplement
- Ability to manage agreements based on BRRD status and track agreement status in Transition Center.
- Manage adoption letters and transition notices involving non-conformed counterparties.



USING THE BRRD PROTOCOL

Adopting the Protocol

- For firms using the Docs platform, the BRRD Protocol can be adopted from inside the platform by users with the ability to sign legal agreements (Execution Phase Approvers & Party Admins).
- Non-conformed parties can adopt the Protocol by sending a signed adoption letter to FIA
 Tech's Client Services team (<u>docs.support@fia-tech.com</u>) who will upload the letter into
 Docs and conduct Protocol notifications.
- Firms may review their own adoption status through the UserHub> My Account>
 Agreements & Protocols page, as well as adopt the Protocol on behalf of permissioned parties

Reviewing adoption status of counterparties

 Conformed parties may review the adoption status of their counterparties directly within Docs, via the Counterparty report.

Sending a Transition Notice

INCORPORATING BRRD LANGUAGE INTO GIVE UP AGREEMENTS - WORKFLOW

Within the Application, firms will be able to initiate Protocol-eligible transitions directly within the Transition Center, as well as review transitions of agreements to which you are a party.

To incorporate standard BRRD language into agreements:

- Select the agreement(s) eligible to incorporate BRRD language.
- Determine which BRRD clauses to apply to the agreement(s).
- Select the desired effective date of agreements resulting from the transition (noting that this date must be greater than 3 business days from the current day).
- Initiate transition to distribute notices to counterparties and begin the transition process.



NON-CONFORMED PARTIES: PARTICIPATING IN THE PROTOCOL

- Non-Docs users can adopt the Protocol by sending FIA Tech a copy of the signed adoption letter.
- Any Notices will be emailed by FIA Tech to the email address(es) specified in your adoption letter.
- You may update recipients additional to those indicated in your adoption letter by emailing FIA Tech at protocol@fia-tech.com.
- If you, upon receipt of a Transition Notice, wish to reject the full notice, or part of the notice, a rejection letter must be sent to FIA Tech at protocol@fia-tech.com.

TIMELINE

- Adoption of the Protocol is currently available for all firms!
 - Aug. 29th: Protocol made available for firms to adopt within application, and via external adoption letters.
 - **Mid-Sept. (target):** Support for Eligible Senders to send Transition Notices on eligible agreements.
 - Mid-Oct (target): Additional enhancements for ongoing inclusion of BRRD language within new GUAs.
